What is the English for Specific Purposes Program?

English for Specific Purposes (ESP) is a learner-centered approach to teaching English as an additional language which focuses on developing English communication skills in a specific discipline, such as accounting, agrolology, education, engineering, IT technology, and academic learning. Students are also exposed to Canadian business or academic culture and real world communication practice.

The English for Specific Purposes (ESP) Program of The University of Winnipeg offers courses in two streams:

English for Professional Purposes

These classes focus on the development of job-specific English language skills for students who seek to enter or advance in their professions.

English for Internationally Educated **Accountants**
Language and Communication for Internationally Educated **Agrologists**
English for **Engineering Professionals** (classroom or online)
English for **IT Professionals**
Communication for Internationally Educated **Teachers** (classroom and online)
Technical Communication for **Engineering Professionals**

English for Academic Purposes
