All Manitobans are eligible for the Human Rights Commitment Award of Manitoba, and
those less than twenty-five years old can be nominated for the
Sybil Shack Human Rights Youth Award.

Every year, on International Human Rights Day, The Manitoba Human Rights
Commission, the Canadian Human Rights Commission and the Manitoba Association for
Rights and Liberties acknowledge human rights work that has had an impact on the
advancement of Manitobans. These annual awards recognize those who have promoted
respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms.

 **The 2008 Commitment Award will recognize work, which has advanced
human rights by championing the rights of children.**

 **The Sybil Shack Human Rights Youth Award will recognize a youth
group or young person less than twenty five years of age, who has promoted
respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms within Manitoba.**

for the nominations on a separate page. (Please note that all current MARL, MHRC and
CHRC employees and Board members are excluded.)
